

Spring 2017 Recruitment Guidelines and Rules

I.) Events & Scheduling:

- All IFC affiliated chapters must conduct recruitment events within the IFC-wide recruitment window (January 19th-January 27th, 2017). Unaffiliated chapters will also conduct their recruitment during this time.
- All recruitment event schedules must be submitted to the IFC VP of Recruitment via email to ifc.recruitment@calgreeks.com.
- Hosting a recruitment event outside of your chapter's recruitment schedule is prohibited.
- Registered co-ed events are permitted on Friday, January 27th under the circumstance that your chapter's recruitment is complete by that date. The completion of recruitment must be officially declared via email to the IFC President and VP of Recruitment. If your chapter's recruitment week is completed on or before Friday, January 27th your chapter is permitted to host a co-ed event if and only if the event is registered with Berkeley Fire Department.
- Failure to observe these policies will result in referral to IFC Standards Board.

II.) Conduct & Behavior

- Recruitment events must abide by the event parameters set forth in the IFC Functional Equivalent Exemption to the GLA ordinance (regarding curfews, Responsible Resident neighbor notification, etc).
- Consumption of controlled or uncontrolled intoxicants (by California state definition) is prohibited during scheduled recruitment events.
- Presence of sorority women/female-identified students is prohibited during scheduled recruitment events.
- Presence of "hard" alcohol (>20% ABV) during scheduled recruitment events will result in an immediate monetary fine of \$20 per member.
- Failure to observe these policies will result in referral to IFC Standards Board.

III.) Further Reminders

- All conventional GLA/IFC regulations must be observed during recruitment events.
- All recruitment events in excess of 50 guests must have an approved indoor event permit from Berkeley Fire Department.
- Please ensure that your weekday events do not continue beyond the standard weekday curfew for events/noise.
- Please ensure all visible garbage/waste from recruitment events is disposed of in marked containers, and ensure your property remains tidy throughout the week.
- Failure to observe these policies will result in a referral to IFC Standards Board.
